POSITION OVERVIEW

Urban Pathways K-5 College Charter School is seeking a committed and culturally responsive educator to serve as the Assistant Dean of Students. This individual will work closely with the Dean of Students and Student Affairs Coordinator to support a safe, inclusive, and student-centered school environment. The Assistant Dean will provide hands-on behavioral and operational support to promote positive school culture and ensure scholars have the structures needed to thrive.



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CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Student Support & Culture Building

- Reinforce the school-wide behavior matrix and uphold school culture expectations
- Support restorative interventions, student check-ins, and daily behavior coaching
- Supervise common spaces (arrival, lunch, recess, dismissal) and ensure student safety
- Assist with restorative circles, mediations, and re-entry meetings
- Support implementation of Tier II/III behavior plans in partnership with the MTSS team
- Communicate with families regarding behavioral incidents, follow-ups, and support plans

MTSS Collaboration

- Assist in collecting and reviewing student behavior, attendance, and SEL data
- Collaborate with the MTSS team to implement Tier I interventions with fidelity
- Support intervention logistics and monitor student participation in assigned supports
- Participate in MTSS team meetings and behavior support planning

Operational & Daily Responsibilities

- Input student behavior data into PowerSchool and maintain accurate logs
- Track daily attendance and flag patterns that require follow-up
- Maintain hallway presence and serve as a first responder to behavior incidents
- Coordinate with school security and administrative staff as needed
- Assist with school safety drills, arrival/dismissal protocols, and culture initiatives
